

Accessible Books

Books with pictures are most ideal to adapt into "accessible books". With the use of a scanner, clips of the pictures can be attached to sound clips, recorded by the teacher or assistant and are placed in a Powerpoint file.

Once burned onto a CD, the student can access the book with the aid of a switch and Switch Interface.

Sometimes, it is challenging trying to locate books, which are age appropriate and include photos with minimal and simple text. However, these kinds of books are ideal for those older students who may either have limited reading vocabulary or not read at all. Authors, Ed & Ruth Radlauer, have developed about 200 books which are designed for older readers with limited reading abilities.
