

## Resource Room Jobs

The following are a list of jobs that your student and his/her classmates might rotate through in the resource room. Jobs offer opportunities for all students to be of service while practicing skills within meaningful and functional activities.

• stack chairs	• get music instruments out for class
• sweep floor	• wash dishes
• switch names for jobs	• put tools into caddy (tidy)
• return library books	• dry & put away dishes
• computers (turn on/off & tidy)	• laundry
• shred paper	• load/unload dishwasher
• clean and tidy desks	• collect attendance
• stack stools	• water plants
• wash lunch tables	• tidy science tables
