

Taking a Survey Using the Step-by-Step Communicator*



This activity encourages interaction in an inclusive setting.

Use a tape recorder to collect the data. Later, the information can be used in different ways, such as in a math activity that involves counting the different types of responses collected.

Ideas for message sequence on the Step-by-Step Communicator:

1. Excuse me.
2. Do you have a minute to participate in a survey?
3. Which ice cream do you like better, vanilla or chocolate?
4. Thank-you!

Ideas for surveys:

1. Elections – candidates and opinion polls
2. Favourite restaurant
3. Favourite TV show
4. Favourite music group
5. Answering questions such as “what did you do on your summer vacation”, or “what did you get for Christmas?”
