

Options For Making Choices To Share With Group Home & Day Program

Please ask me questions and give me opportunities to make choices in my day, in the following ways...

When I am enjoying an activity, you can stop and ask me to look at you if I want "**more**" of it.

(e.g., "Look at me if you want more whispers".)



You can offer me a choice between 2 **objects**, which are held up in front of me. I will look at the one I want.

(Follow the scripted routine for choice making in the communication goal.)

You can ask me a **yes/no question** for activities that are familiar. I can smile or look at you or the object for "yes". I may purse my lips or not respond, for "no". (Remember to pause and give me time to respond.)

**(Do you want to listen to some more music in your chair?)*



If I don't make a choice in any of the above ways, then you have two options...

- Make a choice yourself and then respond to my reaction. If I don't seem to like it, then ask me to make a choice the next time.
- You can try to offer me a different choice I might want, that is outside of those previously offered.
